Sign In

- Go to Learningpod.com
- Click “Log In” in the top right corner
- Enter your email and password, click “log in”.

Finding Questions

Browsing

- Click “Browse Topics” in the top navigation menu
- Select Topic, Exam, or Student Level on the left
- Select a listing or sub-listing to browse

Searching

- Find the search bar in the top navigation bar (look for the shaded box)
- Search for a term, topic, grade number, or specific question (i.e. “grade 3”)
- You can look at “pod” or question results

Your Dashboard

The dashboard allows you to access your site history. All of the questions, quizzes and homeworks you’ve created will be listed on this page. Navigate to sections using the sidebar on the left. (Hint: as a teacher you’ll most often use “Published Pods” and “Published Questions”)

Creating Quizzes and Homework

Adding Questions

- Find an appropriate question using search or browse
- In the top right corner of the question, click “add to pod”
- Repeat until you’ve added the questions you need for that pod

Publishing Pod

- Click the blue pod button (with the number) on the top right of the page
- Enter a title for your pod (ex: Ms. Smith’s Week 3 Physics Quiz)
- Enter a description giving details of the pod content
- Scroll down to select a topic(s)
- Check off all appropriate grade levels
- Click Publish

Assigning Quizzes and Homework

- Open up your “pod” link to the cover page
- Copy the unique URL listed on the page
- Send the URL to your students

Results will automatically be tracked based on the classroom groups established for your pilot program. To see your students results right away, ask them to “Email Results” directly from their summary page.
